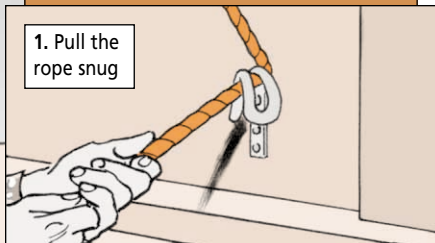
TIED UP IN KNOTS?

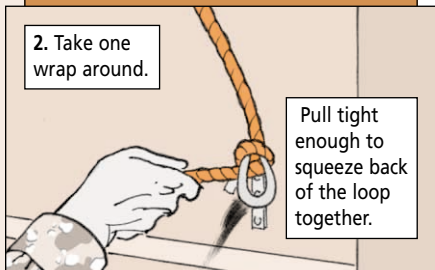


Drivers, a cargo cover that flaps in the wind is a quick way to waste your unit's money. Save money and the truck's cargo cover with this easy, no-knot tiedown that keeps the cover snug, but not so tight the lashing ropes tear the cover:

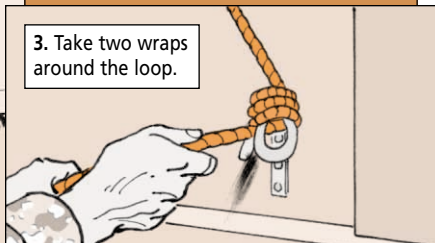
1. Pull the rope snug



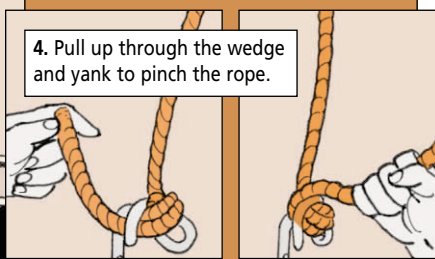
2. Take one wrap around.



3. Take two wraps around the loop.



4. Pull up through the wedge and yank to pinch the rope.



5. Tuck the end through the loop and you're finished.
